Gospel Arts Manna Care Instructions for Choir Gowns

These Choir Gowns remain the property of Gospel Manna[®] and as such are to be used solely for religious purposes i.e. gospel concerts, weddings and church services; any other use is to be requested in writing to the address below. The care of each gown forms an important part of the terms of hire and anyone who will be wearing the gowns are to be made aware of this document.

The hire of the gowns is on the basis of the occasion given and agreed in the Hire Contract and must not be used outside of this agreement.

- 1. The signatory on the contract is responsible for inspecting each gown to confirm they are in excellent condition prior to collecting them
- 2. Check that each gown does not touch the floor whilst being worn
- 3. If heals are worn, allow floor clearance of two inches to prevent the hem from tearing
- 4. For health & safety reasons, gowns should be removed when ascending and descending stairs
- 5. When raining, gowns should be removed before going outdoors
- 6. For reasons of hygiene, gowns should be removed prior to entering the bathroom
- 7. When gowns are not in use they should be hung on the hanger, hook secured and placed back into their respective protective bag
- 8. When packing away, place no more than three gowns into each carrier case
- 9. At no time should amendments/adjustments be made to any of the gowns and the hooks should not be tampered with
- 10. During transportation of the gowns try not to place each carrier directly on top of each other to avoid crushing

Each gown is inspected prior to hire and they are hired out in excellent condition. It is the conditions of hire that they are returned in the same condition.
