glected works of art (usually items made for special events like nativity, anniversary or Easter celebrations) that once finished with, often get discarded.

Gospel Arts Manna is also a resource centre with a comprehensive database and training packs for radio presenters and producers. There

is also an arts directory on sale.

The third reason why Gospel Arts Manna was set up is to promote all Christian artistes whatever their genre so that many other groups can benefit from their services.

A new project is under way to build a Christian Art Centre in the Caribbean.

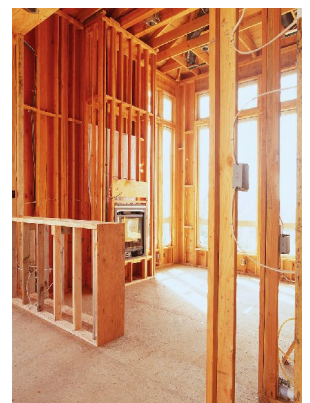
We welcome your ideas for the building's planning and will aim to have plans submitted by Autumn 2007.
